BWSC is a Danish power plant developer, turnkey and operation Contractor. Being a world-leading turnkey and operation Contractor for medium and large scale Diesel and gas based power generation systems, BWSC's experience and expertise ranges from every aspect of plant design to rehabilitation, operation, maintenance, project development, and financial engineering.

Within three decades, BWSC has supplied more than 148 power plants to 48 countries, with a total generating capacity in excess of 2,000 MW and has performed long-term Operation, Maintenance and Technical Support Agreements covering a total plant capacity in excess of 1,100 MW. BWSC has demonstrated its ability to successfully develop Diesel Power Plants internationally, including major private owned power plants in Sri Lanka and Panama.

BWSC has its origin in the stationary engine division of Burmeister & Wain, which has built and installed diesel engines for power plant applications since 1904. BWSC was established as an independent specialist company in 1980 and developed to be a highly specialized and reputable actor in its business segment of Diesel power.

State-of-the-art Project in Greece

In 2002, BWSC entered into a turnkey contract with the Public Power Corporation (PPC) for a new power plant located in Atherinolakkos - Crete. The power station comprised two 2-stroke Diesel engines each with a capacity of 51 MW, being the largest size of Diesel engines built for stationary applications



BWSC designed, engineered, constructed and commissioned the turnkey project as the major partner in a Consortium. The 2-stroke engines are manufactured under license of MAN B&W Diesel by Mitsui Engineering and Shipbuilding Co., Ltd of Japan. Most needed delivery of power to the grid was achieved 4 months ahead of the scheduled date, thus enabling availability of power during the Olympic Games of 2004. The plant has proven a unique and second to none performance with respect to reliable and cost efficient base load power generation since its commissioning in 2004.

Presently, BWSC is providing PPC with services of operation and maintenance on site under a service contract. The availability figures achieved have reached new worldwide availability records, a fact that has direct positive impact on the power plant economy and hence the overall cost of electricity.
